## **Directions and Parking**

Traffic on I-40 is very heavy during rush hour. Leave early to account for any delays.

Enter the museum at the Reedy Creek Road traffic light. Visitor parking is free and available in the Blue Ridge lot, on the right after the entrance to the museum.

Overflow parking is behind the West Building, on the left after entering the museum drive. Accessible parking areas are available in both lots.

The performance will take place outdoors in the field/hill adjacent to the Volunteer Garden (labeled on the map). There will be a short walk (5–10 minutes) from parking to the performance location behind the amphitheater. Ushers and signage will be available to help you get from the entrance of the amphitheater to the performance location.

The performance will begin promptly at 7:00 pm.

Run Time: 45–50 minutes, no intermission

Seating is on the lawn. Please bring your chair or blanket if preferred. Very limited chairs will be available.
