Bryan Center Parking Garage (136 Science Drive, Durham, NC 27705)

ADA parking in the surface lot at Bryan Center (135 Science Drive, Durham, NC 27705)

Option 1:

Bring \$5 cash to enter the garage or surface lot each time you attend a performance.
ONLY CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED. Exact amount appreciated. Change for small bills possible.

Option 2:

To purchase a voucher online BEFORE arriving on Duke University's campus visit <https://my.parking.duke.edu/> and complete the following steps:

1. If you are a Duke employee, student, or sponsored guest, sign in with "NetID Login."
 - If not affiliated with Duke University, select "Log in with OneLink."
2. Click on "Purchase Event Parking," then select the event you would like to purchase a permit for.
3. Confirm that you want to purchase parking for the selected event. During this step, you can select ADA parking if eligible.
4. Fill out the payment information and click pay.
5. Once you have paid for parking, you will see a QR code displayed on the screen.

You can then:

- save the QR code in your digital wallet or access through your Duke Parking account
- screenshot or print the QR code

Please note: You must show the QR code in order to enter the parking garage or surface lot.

The receipt in your email does not include a QR code and will not be accepted by the parking attendant.

You must purchase vouchers individually for each performance.

\$5 cash or prepaid voucher with QR code must be presented to enter the parking deck or surface lot.

Credit Cards WILL NOT be accepted so please plan ahead for yourself and your fellow attendees!
